

Hornet Card Expectations

Each teacher will decide if their students will keep the cards or if they will be kept together.

Hornet-cards will not be taken out of the classroom.

- Specials teachers and other staff will inform the classroom teacher who earned a punch.

Once a student fills up a punch card:

- Spin the “prize wheel” during Hornet Huddle.
- If more than one card is filled up that week, students will be written a hornet pride.

The hornet-cards should help to enforce the 4:1 in any setting throughout the building.

Examples of when it is appropriate to punch a card:

- A student drops a pencil box, and a friend helps them pick it up.
- Lining up quietly.
- Raising your hand to talk in the classroom.
- Walking on the lines in the hallway.
- Cleaning up your spot at lunch.
- Following bathroom expectations.

Each teacher will keep all hornet-cards once filled up. Once you reach a certain amount the whole class will celebrate.
